IMPLEMENTATION

- Engage young boys (7–11 years) within communities through a long-term structured intervention model based on a gender-transformative curriculum.
- Engage young boys in schools by implementing a structured school-based intervention model.

Statutory compliances including 12A and 80G



Strong local presence in proposed geography



Minimum 5 years of experience working with children, gender, education, life skills, or social behaviour change programs



Proven experience working with schools and/or communities
